County Commissioner Ron Bacon reported that school officers will be paid for three years. They have ordered four F-150 pickups, which are now on backorder, for the Sheriff's Department.

Harold Morse reported that he did not notice any oak wilt at the cemetery. The leaves are mostly cleaned up. The Vacuum for picking up leaves caught on fire. He and Dan Morse fixed it to finish the job, but a new vacuum will need to be purchased. Discussion was held and the board decided that we will budget \$3,000 for the purchase in the 2023-24 budget.

Clerk presented the PASAR Report on Roads and Culverts that was received from the Road Commission.

In old business, Bids for a new roof on the hall were read. Superior Exteriors \$25,871 with a 25-year warranty and At the Peak \$17,905 with a 10-year warranty. No action was taken. Cormany will check how long the bids are good for.

In new business, Clerk made a motion to transfer \$800 from Contingencies to Elections and \$250 from Contingencies to Sanitation. Motion supported by Cormany and carried.

Motion to pay bills by Cormany, supported by C. Gulembo; carried.

Motion to adjourn by Borema, supported by M. Gulembo; carried.
