

SHERIDAN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING
MINUTES

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, April 18, 2023, held at the Sheridan Township Hall at 8:00 p.m. Present were Corliss Gulembo, Marlynn Gulembo, Jennie Borema, Jeffrey Cormany, and 10 guests.

Pledge to the Flag.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion to approve by Cormany, supported by C. Gulembo; carried.

Clerk reported that the Clerk's and Treasurer's books balance at \$322,409.75, prior to the meeting.

Sheriff Cole gave the report for February and March and also for 2022. He reported that the Sheriff's Department has been covering for Scottville because they are shorthanded. New gun laws in Michigan do not go into effect until March 2025.

Assessor Mike Banninga presented the Local Market Update through March 2023, noting that the number of homes sold and the sale price are still increasing.

In old business, Clerk reported that there is a correction on the Beginning Balance on the budget. \$108,027 of ARPA money was included in the Beginning Balance and also as ARPA Funds. Motion to accept this correction to the 2023-24 budget by Cormany, supported by C. Gulembo. Motion carried.

Clerk announced the Mason County Township Officers' meeting will be held on April 20, 6 p.m., at Amber Township Hall.

Cormany reported on the Supervisor's meeting he attended. Brining will be the same this year as in the past, but next year there may possibly be no brining within 25'-50' of lakes.

Discussion was held on ORV stickers for golf carts and road projects.

Clerk read a letter from the Mason County Treasurer regarding the Township's second right of refusal the purchase two properties in Oak Openings. Motion by Cormany, supported by C. Gulembo, to refuse the offer. Motion carried. Clerk will inform the County Treasurer.

Motion to pay bills, by Cormany, supported by C. Gulembo. This includes paying Winkleblack the balance of the amount owed, including up to \$200 for a repair on the roof, which the Clerk will pay when the bill is received. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn by M. Gulembo, supported by Cormany; carried.
