

SHERIDAN TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING
MINUTES

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, June 20, 2023, held at the Sheridan Township Hall at 8:00 p.m. Present were Corliss Gulembo, Marlynn Gulembo, Jennie Borema, Jeffrey Cormany, Doug Damkoehler, and 11 guests.

Pledge to the Flag.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion to approve by Cormany, supported by Damkoehler; carried.

Clerk reported that the Clerk's and Treasurer's books balance at \$323,224.30, prior to the meeting.

Sheriff Cole gave the monthly activity report, noting 16 calls for service. He reported that there were no Gus Macker arrests this year.

Assessor Mike Banninga reported that, according to the county residential sales study, sales are still climbing. He has a Tax Tribunal trial and may need to travel to Lansing for 2 days. He asked the Board to allow him to hire an attorney, if needed. He is trying to settle the matter prior to the trial. Motion to hire an attorney for this purpose by Cormany, support by Damhoehler; carried. He also announced that the July Board of Review will be held on July 18 at noon at the Township Hall.

Don Mead reported that the drainage is poor on Sugar Grove Rd., east of Benson. Cormany will contact Josh at the Road Commission. He was advised that both are primary roads.

Steve Klop reported that the "park" property on Griffin Rd. has a semi load of sand near the lake. Also, Dewey Rd. has not been repaired yet from a snow plowing mishap by the Road Commission.

Clerk presented an EGLE Notice of Authorization to Tom Welch for shoreline work on Ford Lake and also authorization given to Burke Larsen for a large quantity water withdrawal from the South Branch Lincoln River.

Borema reported that online tax payments will be available on our website July 5 – September 12.

M. Gulembo reported that she will remove the COVID-19 precautions statement on the Hall Rental Agreement.

Motion to pay bills, by Cormany, supported by Damkoehler; carried.

Motion to adjourn by M. Gulembo, supported by Borema; carried.
