Sheriff Cole presented the November activity report. There were 8 calls for service, including 1 crash; there were no criminal calls. He also reported that the Mason County Sheriff's Department humbly (badly) beat Oceana County in the recent Blood Drive competition.

Commissioner Ron Bacon was present but had no activity to report on.

Assessor Mike Banninga reported that the parties involved with the recent Tribunal appeal, which was settled out of court, did not receive the correction on their tax bill. A new bill was sent.

Ed Lijewski reported that The Fountain Fire Department has had 220 calls this year, 55 for fire and 165 medical.

Clerk presented two contracts for pulverizing Morse Rd. from Dewey to Millerton. Cormany will ask Mary Samuels about the rest of the work (wedging).

Discussion was held on the Road Improvement Millage, which expires this year (2023). Clerk will prepare the Resolution to ask voters for a renewal of that millage on the August 2024 ballot.

Clerk Marlynn Gulembo made a motion to adopt the Resolution Establishing Early Voting Precinct. Motion supported by Cormany. Supervisor Corliss Gulembo declared the Resolution adopted unanimously following a roll call vote.
